Please allow this letter to serve as notice that one of your yahoo users has committed a criminal act using his yahoo.com email account:

He stole our corporate laptop today and when he was apprehended by the WV State Police he had deleted four month's worth of corporate intellectual property – everything that had been put on the laptop since I had purchased it at the end of January 2015.

As Chairman of the National Alliance, this individual, Randolph L.
